

ADMINISTRATIVE AND ACADEMIC STRUCTURE AT THE POLICE COLLEGE

The Police College is a part of the Ministry of Interior Affairs, within the Police Directorate i.e. the Police Academy as a directly superior organisational form. The Supervisory Board with 5 members has a supervisory and managerial role before the Ministry as a founder. The Police College has a total of 31 employees. It is indirectly supervised by a dean/head of the Police College with two directly subordinate assistants, the assistant head for professional study and the assistant head for development, research and university study. The Teachers' Council of the Police College comprising of teaching staff and student representatives also take part in making decisions on professional issues. The Teachers' Council of the Police College has 30 members and two student representatives who also take part in decision making. Within the Police College, there is also a Police Research Centre. The administrative and technical work will be allocated to the secretary of the Police College and the student registry. The library and publishing services is within the scope of the Police Academy and is partially within the operation of the Police College.

Dean of the Police College is a head of the Police College and performs his activities in accordance with the general regulations, Regulation on the Regulation on Internal Rules of the Ministry of Interior Affairs of the Republic of Croatia and the Statute of the Police College; makes decisions on cooperation with other HEIs in Croatia and abroad; makes decisions in relation to the academic courses and students statuses which are not within the scope of the Teachers' Council, signs diplomas and supplementary study certificates and other public documents issued by the Police College; signs the agreements concluded by the Police College. The head of the Police College - the Dean - has two assistant deans, for undergraduate and graduate studies and for research, development and university study.

The Assistant Dean of the Police College for Graduate Studies coordinates, delegates and provides professional guidelines and provides instructions for execution of the activities from the development plans, provides professional monitoring of the teaching processes in graduate studies, organises preparation of curricula and proposes their adoption.

The Assistant Dean of the Police College for research, development and university Studies provides professional supervisions of the departments on drawing up scientific, professional and other projects and studies; cooperates with the interested organisations in making studies, expertises, analyses, surveys, professional and scientific projects and coordinates the participation of the teachings staff of the Police College; negotiate prospective Erasmus agreements with new higher education institutions or extending and amending agreements already entered into with existing partner institutions, monitor the validity period of the agreements in their area and organise student and staff selection in the HEI based on the information provided by the Institutional Coordinator.
