

LANGUAGE POLICY

The Police College courses catalogue is published for every academic year. It is published in Croatian and English language. Croatian is the official language in the country and therefore most of the courses will be conducted in Croatian. The Police College offers 38 courses in English aimed especially at international exchange students.

Language policy for preparing participants for mobility

In order to assure high quality mobility of students and staff, the Police College takes care that all participants in mobility have satisfactory level of knowledge in English language or in the language of host institution. Within selection procedure for outgoing mobility of students, proficiency of students in foreign languages is checked within oral and written examination by following the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Before beginning of mobility, students are offered intensive language consultations delivered by two senior lecturers in English at the Police College.

Language support for incoming students and staff with a minimum of 2-month mobility period

Intensive course in Croatian language has not been organised for international students so far, but we are preparing agreements with the Faculty of Philosophy, Department of Croatian Language and Literature at the University of Zagreb for future cooperation. However, two senior lecturers in English language at the Police College are ready to help them understand and use familiar everyday expressions and very basic phrases aimed at the satisfaction of needs of a concrete type.
